The fault here is not with the book but with the seller's storage procedures. The smell is strong enough that it appears that anyone picking up the book and processing it for mailing would notice the smell immediately.2 of 2 people found the following review helpful. The inside cover shows a drawing covering all the buildings and walls with names. Then using diagrams the history of the expansion of this fortress is discussed. Chapters cover the Western Entrance, the Medieval Palace, Wall Walk, Crown Jewels, Tower Green, White Tower, Fusciliers' Museum, the

Wharf, and The History of the Tower. There are exterior and interior color photos. The knight's armor is not shown. The Crown Jewels are touched on but if you really want to see them, I recommend The Crown Jewels Official Guide which I wrote a review on. At the time of this writing, the price was \$3.50-10.50 which is reasonable.
