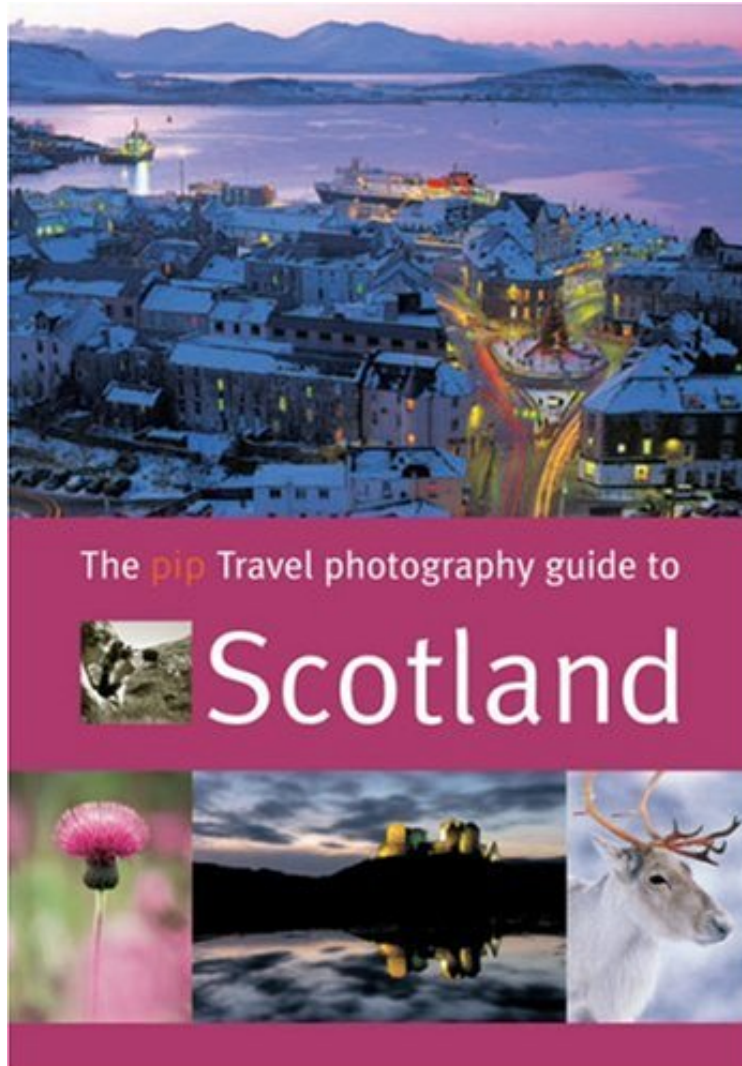

I was pretty disappointed in this book, although others might still find it useful. The problem I had is that it covers the whole country but there are only a few sites for each area. So unless you have six weeks (or more) to cover the whole country there will only be a few topics in one area that are useful. And even if you had that much time, for each area this book might cover one topic and then you will be on your own for the rest. For example, for Isle of Skye it mentions one or two obscure places but misses some of the obvious places, like the Quiraing. This

would be like a book on the US that tells you to go to New York and see the Statue of Liberty, go to DC and see the Washington Monument, go to Florida and take a picture of the beach, go to California and see the Golden Gate Bridge and El Capitan, and Yellowstone to see Old Faithful. Yes, I suppose you could travel the whole country like that, but you would miss a million things. One of the other reviews mentions that there are better books available.
