The information, names, roads, and details were accurate--even in quite remote, non-touristy parts of the country. It's printed on plastic paper which means it can take a beating; It's essentially water and tear proof. I appreciated and actually used some of the more obscure map symbols and information such as archaeological site, cave, swamp, elevation, and such. I also used this map to locate some small rivers for fishing. I credit the map for getting me into some great fly fishing adventures that were not listed in any guide book. Croatia is long, skinny in places, and a rather inconvenient shape for printing on a map. The author splits the country in half and you can't see the entire country printed together. While annoying, I can understand why this was done. Either one prints it small to keep it on one page, sacrificing detail or one keeps the detail and prints on different sides or on a large and unwieldy piece of paper. Oh well.
