The guide is an accomplice to the tourist traps of the city, leading hapless travelers directly into the very worst restaurants that cost the very most. We have quickly learned to ignore the guide's restaurant listings, and have instead found it useful to just wander the streets reading menus. There are plenty of other issues with the book: poor descriptions of the ancient Roman sites, lackluster guidance on how to enjoy the Vatican, useless descriptions of transportation options, etc... Do yourself a favor, and avoid this book.
