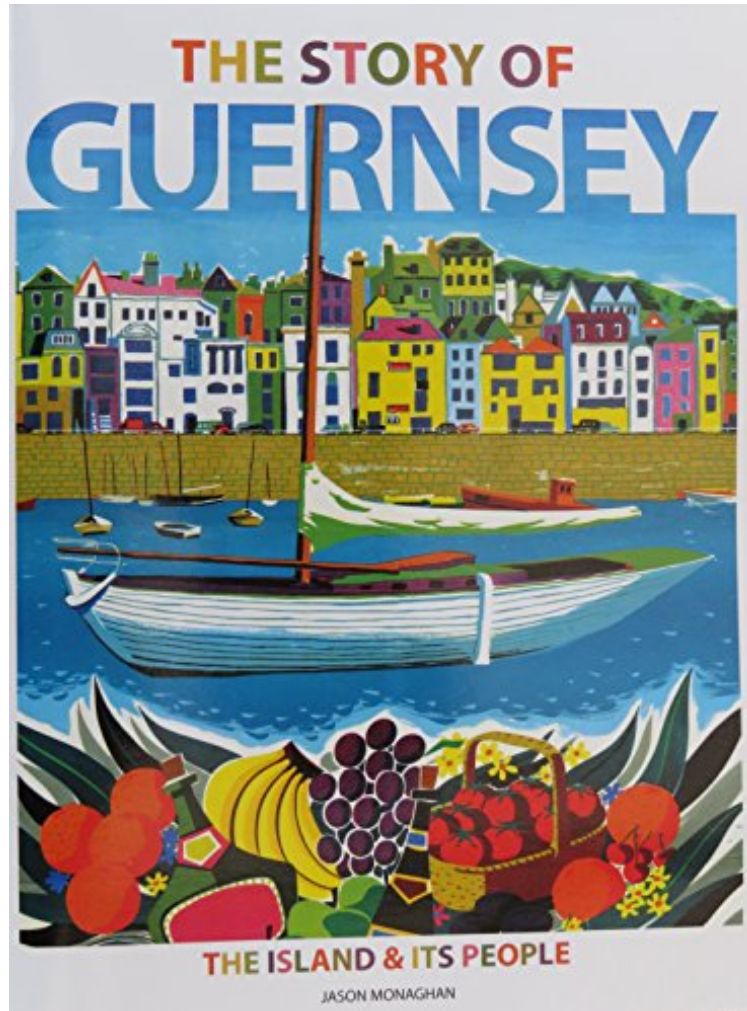

I wrote the first draft more or less straight from memory, then researched the gaps in my knowledge - moving out of my traditional comfort zone as a Romanist and military historian. My research was assisted by colleagues at the Museum and we hunted out some of the best graphic art used to illustrate our exhibitions - mostly by artist Bryan Byron. It has been my best-selling book to date and is also now available in French.
