But I'm not one of those people, and I don't use the book in a practical way. I'm one of those other people, scattered all over the world, who wish they lived in London. It gives you a different view of that wonderful metropolis than guidebooks do. You find out how many people actually

live in the City of London (7,800). You learn that even in the wealthy suburb of Richmond, more people live in apartments than houses. There's lots of the nitty gritty tourists don't have to worry about--information on schools and taxes, for instance. But this isn't just a fact book. It has plenty of opinion and gossip about various neighborhoods and the people who live in them. The maps and color photographs are up to the high Time Out magazine standard. On the minus side, much of the book is devoted to listings of businesses, shops and restaurants, and these go out of date very quickly. Also, I wish they wouldn't put advertising in a book. But if you like to daydream about being a Londoner, this is the book for you.
