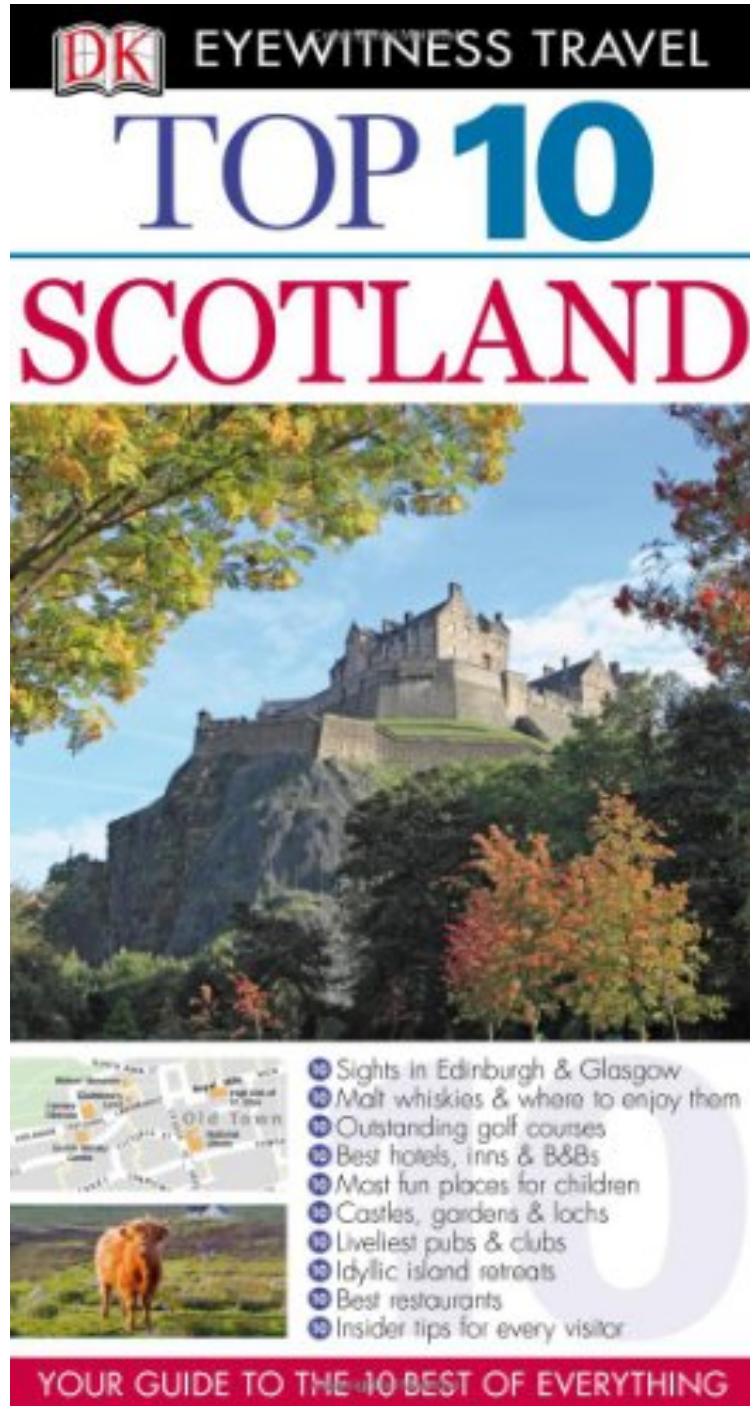

In just 160 pages, newly updated for 2013, this guide focuses on the very best that Scotland has to offer, in a format loaded with pictures, maps, graphics, minimal text, and plenty of website addresses for further research. "Top Ten Scotland" shares some information in common with the longer and more detailed "DK Eyewitness Scotland Guide", but has its own format, tightly focused on the priorities of the busy traveler. The guide offers the ten best things to see in all of Scotland, then drills down to a variety of additional top ten lists by region and by category. Among the categories are castles, formal gardens, fishing spots, golf courses, distilleries, traditional Highland events, attractions for children, restaurants, and some best-kept secrets. Other categories include best museums, best long distance hiking trails, and best Munro's (mountains) to climb. The guide does include some practical information on when and how to go to Scotland, and how to get around once you get there. It's nicely organized, heavily illustrated, and very portable.
